

Rule 201. Bar of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

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Official Note: If a person's admission to practice law or limited license to practice law as an in-house corporate counsel, **military attorney, spouse of an active-duty service member, attorney participant in defender or legal service programs,** or foreign legal consultant is revoked for a material misrepresentation or omission, the person will be required to reapply de novo. . . .

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Rule 203. Admission by Bar Examination

- (a) **Bar Examination.** The general requirements for permission to sit for the bar examination are:

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- (2) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph 2(ii) of this Rule, completion of the study of law at and receipt without exception of an earned Bachelor of Laws or Juris Doctor degree from a law school that was an accredited law school at the time the applicant matriculated or graduated. See Rule 205 (relating to admission **[by bar examination for graduates with foreign law degrees]of foreign attorneys and graduates of foreign institutions**) for standards applicable to graduates of foreign law schools; or

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
